Purpose

Dressage NZ is seeking Expressions of Interest from ESNZ registered Performance or Elte Coaches for the Adult Rider Camp from 4pm, Friday 6 September to 5pm, 8 September 2024.

The camp is to be held at Selwyn Equestrian Centre, Burnham, Christchurch.

The camp is designed to offer Adult Riders at any level the opportunity to have lessons with a higher level ESNZ qualified coach, ride a test in front of a judge, and attend lectures around the welfare of the horse and other topics such as the scale of training.

Alongside this camp the Development Committee will run a Coach Education Camp. This camp will be overseen by a separate Coach Educator. The attending coaches will be watching some of the adult rider lessons. It is planned to have some discussion amongst the camps at specially assigned times.

Qualification Requirements

- Coach must be an ESNZ Performance or Elite level
- Coaches must have a current First Aid Certificate at time of camp.

Key Attributes and Role Description

- Coaches will need to be adaptable and confident coaching both ridden sessions and off horse sessions in respect to topics requested by the Development Committee
- Can constructively voice feedback on video footage, deliver presentations, and lead discussion and observation groups.
