Local Officials -4-Local Events

A Resource for Organising Committees to help develop a pool of officials for their event We all know that Eventing needs many people on the ground to run the sport and having new officials coming on board is crucial to the sustainability of Eventing in New Zealand.

With this in mind, the Technical Advisory Group (TAG) has developed a resource pack to support areas in recruiting and starting aspiring officials on their journey to become course designers, technical delegates, cross country judges or ground jury, and stewards.

TAG is suggesting that a person on your Organising Committee take the role of Officials Coordinator and support any aspiring officials to begin the shadowing and paperwork process to become a List 3 official. At the same time TAG has developed a list of Technical Advisors throughout the country that you can touch base with to ask questions, get information or to give your aspiring official further experience with.

The Organising Committee official's coordinator role is not envisioned as an onerous one. You may be supporting one or two people from your Area at a time. The idea is that you, as an experienced Eventing person can help the aspiring official to shadow at events., get to a seminar and to fill out the paperwork to become a List 3 official. The TAG Liaison for each official group is also always available to help you alongside the Technical Advisors. Once a person is on the List and has started their education journey as an official the TAG liaison would take over the promotion, assessment and movement up through the lists.

Application Forms

All officials start off as List 3, and although this allows the person to officiate on their own at the lower level it should still be under the guidance of a more senior official for support and confidence.
